





The Ontario Universities' Application Centre ("OUAC", "we" or "us"), a division of the Council of Ontario Universities (COU), is committed to respecting your privacy. We process applications for admission to Ontario university programs on behalf of the Ontario universities. To apply for admission to an undergraduate university program in Ontario, or to an Ontario medical school, law school, teacher education program, or rehabilitation sciences program, your application is processed through the OUAC. We also process applications for other graduate and professional programs offered by the Ontario universities and for transcripts for the Ontario College of Teachers and the Qualifications Evaluation Council of Ontario. The purpose of this Privacy Statement is to inform you about our privacy practices, including how we collect, use and disclose your personal information.

What Information Do We Collect?

We collect personal information about you in the following ways:

Information You Provide to Us

- · We collect the personal information you provide in your application, or in reference to your application.
- We may ask for personal information that you are not required to provide to complete your application. E.g., You may
 provide personal information in connection with special programs or surveys.
- We collect payment information when you pay (or someone else pays) for your application, except for payment card information.
- · We may ask for your personal information when you contact us with a comment or question.

We do not collect payment card information. If you make an online payment using a payment card, such as a credit card or debit card, you are connected directly to our online payment processing service provider and your payment card information is collected and processed by that service provider.

Information We Collect from Third Parties

We collect personal information about you from other sources, as required, such as your high school, other academic
institutions you attended, third-party test score providers and references.

Information We Collect Automatically

- · We collect the following information when you visit the OUAC website:
 - your device's Internet Protocol address (e.g., IP 324.45.123.11);
 - your device's operating system and the web browser you use to view the OUAC website;
 - the referring site, if applicable;
 - the pages you visit on the OUAC website; and
 - the date, time and duration of your visit.
- . We track your online activity on the OUAC website using cookies and web analytics.

How Do We Use Your Information?

We use your personal information to:

- · process your application to Ontario universities and provide other services to you.
- · verify and confirm the information in your application.
- · maintain and improve the OUAC's application system.
- · contact you regarding your application and other services, including by email.
- · respond to your inquiries and requests.
- · process electronic transcript and test score requests.
- · process and respond to any inquiries about your payment.
- create data and aggregated data and reports to be used by us, educational and governmental institutions and researchers.
- · conduct research and analysis and to assist others with research.
- · protect our systems and the integrity of our auditing process.
- · investigate legal claims and enforce our rights and those of the Ontario universities.

We may use your personal information for other purposes we have obtained your consent for and for other purposes as may be permitted or required by applicable law.

Except as otherwise described in this paragraph, we keep your application for 7 years after the end of the annual application cycle (December 2025), then destroy the personally identifiable information and archive the remaining information in accordance with our Data Retention and Disposal Policy. At the end of the annual application cycle, we destroy any supplementary materials (e.g., personal statements, references, etc.) submitted in support of your application. Your information will not be returned, forwarded or copied to you before it is destroyed. If you start but do not submit an application, we will destroy all related personal information at the end of the annual application cycle.

How Do We Share Your Information?

We keep your personal information confidential and disclose it only for the purposes described in this Privacy Statement. We share your personal information with the following third parties:

Universities

- We disclose your application information to your Chosen Universities. The Chosen Universities collect your personal
 information through the OUAC in accordance with their enabling legislation for the purposes of recruitment, admission
 and registration. The notices of collection of personal information for each Ontario university can be found on their
 websites.
- We disclose electronic copies of paper documents to your Chosen Universities, as specified in the application instructions.
- If you apply to a Canadian university outside of Ontario, we disclose your Ontario high school academic data to that university, upon your request.
- . We provide your Chosen Universities access to correspondence about your application.
- If you apply to a joint or collaborative university/university or university/college program, we and/or your Chosen Universities, will disclose your application information to the relevant college or university partner.

Service Providers

- We may transfer your personal information to third parties in order to process electronic transcript requests and to
 retrieve test scores. E.g., if you request an Ontario college transcript in support of a university application, we send your
 personal information to OCAS, which requests Ontario college transcripts on your behalf. We may also request
 transcripts and test scores on your behalf from other organizations in other jurisdictions in Canada and other countries.
- Where an admission test score is required for your application, we provide your personal information to the test score
 providers to obtain your test score. These test score providers may be situated in jurisdictions outside of Canada.
- We may transfer your personal information, as required, to third parties who provide services on our behalf, such as
 hosting, data storage and processing service providers, research and analytics providers and auditors who analyze our
 systems to ensure that your personal information is protected.
- We share your personal information (or the personal information of the person who pays for your application) with your
 credit/debit card company, if applicable, in order to obtain payment authorization. We do not retain any credit/debit card
 information.

Note: Your personal information may be stored and processed in any country where we engage third-party service providers. As a result, your personal information may be transferred outside of Canada to jurisdictions that may have different data protection rules than Canada. While such information is outside of Canada, it is subject to the laws of the country in which it is located, and may be subject to disclosure to the governments, courts or law enforcement or regulatory agencies of said country, pursuant to the laws of such country.

Educational and Governmental Institutions and Researchers

- We may disclose your personal, academic, application choice, offer, confirmation and registration information to the
 Ontario universities and to Ontario high schools and/or school boards for admission, enrollment and other academic
 policy development and research purposes. The notices of collection can be found on the websites of those institutions.
- We may disclose personal information to the Ministry of Colleges and Universities for policy development and research purposes, as outlined in and authorized by the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities Act.
- We may disclose your demographic, academic, application choice, offer, confirmation and registration information to researchers (at the OUAC's discretion) for admission, enrollment and other academic policy development and research purposes.

Additionally, we may use and disclose your information when we believe such use or disclosure is permitted, necessary or appropriate:

- · under applicable law;
- to comply with the legal process or other legal obligations, including our obligations under contracts;
- · to respond to requests from governmental authorities;
- · to protect our operations or those of the universities or other third parties;
- . to protect our rights, privacy, safety and property, and those of our affiliates, you and others; and
- to allow us to pursue available remedies or limit the damages that we may sustain, including the collection of debts you
 may owe us.

We may transfer your personal information and other information to a third party in the event of any reorganization, transfer or other disposition of all or any portion of our operations or assets.

How Do We Protect Your Personal Information?

We maintain administrative, technical and physical safeguards in an effort to protect your personal information against unauthorized access, use, modification and disclosure.

- We restrict access to personal information only to employees and authorized service providers who require the information for the purposes described in this Privacy Statement.
- · We store electronic records off-site as part of our disaster recovery procedures. These records remain in Canada.
- We use industry standard security during the transfer of data. Files transferred to or from the OUAC use a Secure Socket Shell (SSH) protocol. Files containing personal information have an additional layer of encryption.
- Our third-party service providers are required to maintain the confidentiality and security of your personal information and to use it only in compliance with applicable privacy laws.

Although we take appropriate measures to safeguard the personal information in our custody and control, we cannot guarantee that your personal information will always be used in ways that are consistent with this Privacy Statement and no method of transmission or storage of information is 100% secure or error-free, so we cannot guarantee absolute security. If you have reason to believe that your interaction with us is no longer secure (e.g., if you feel that the security of any information you provided to us has been compromised), please contact us immediately.

How Can You Access or Correct Your Personal Information?

During an application cycle, you can access your personal information online and, in most cases, make updates. In cases where you are not able to access your personal information online or make updates, you may submit a written request to review any such personal information about you that we hold and we will provide you with any such personal information to the extent required by law. You may also challenge the accuracy or completeness of your personal information in our records. If you successfully demonstrate that your personal information in our records is inaccurate or incomplete, we will amend the personal information as required.

Third-party Websites and Services

Our websites provide links to third-party websites relevant to the university application process. This Privacy Statement does not extend to any websites, products or services provided by third parties. These linked websites have separate and independent privacy policies, which we recommend you read carefully.

We have no control over such websites and therefore have no responsibility or liability for the manner in which the organizations that operate such linked websites may collect, use, disclose or otherwise process your personal information.

Changes to This Privacy Statement

This Privacy Statement is current as of the "Last updated" date at the top of this page. We may update this Privacy Statement periodically to reflect changes to our personal information practices. We will post the revised privacy statement on this website. We treat your personal information in accordance with the privacy statement in place at the time of collection of such information, or as you otherwise consent.

The Ontario Universities' Application Centre ("OUAC", "we", or "us") is a division of the Council of Ontario Universities (COU). We process applications for admission to Ontario university programs on behalf of the Ontario universities. To apply for admission to an undergraduate degree-granting program and/or a non-degree-granting program at a university in Ontario, your application is processed through the OUAC.

We are committed to respecting your privacy. This notice supplements our Privacy Statement and applies when you prepare, complete and submit an Undergraduate application to an Ontario university. Please read our <u>Privacy Statement</u>.

By applying through the OUAC, you authorize us to collect your personal information directly from you and from other organizations, as necessary, to complete and process your application. You also agree that we will disclose to the universities you apply to (the "Chosen Universities") the personal information you provide to us and other personal information we collect in connection with your application. The Chosen Universities collect your personal information through the OUAC in accordance with their enabling legislation for the purposes of recruitment, admission and registration. Universities may use and disclose your personal information for other purposes in accordance with their own admission and personal information policies and practices. The notices of collection of personal information for each Ontario university can be found on their websites. Please review the policies of your Chosen Universities for further information.

Collection of Personal Information

- We collect the personal information you provide in your application, or in reference to your application, as set out in our Privacy Statement, to process your application to your Chosen Universities, including:
 - Academic transcripts.
 - Your Ontario Education Number (OEN), when it is provided on your transcript; we keep it as a personal identifier for your OUAC Account.
- . We collect information about your status as an Indigenous person of Canada, if you choose to provide it.
- We collect information about your status as a first-generation (parents/guardians did not attend a university or college) applicant, if you choose to provide it.
- We collect information about your gender identity, if you choose to provide it. You may select the "Prefer not to answer" response option if you choose not to provide your gender identity.
- We collect your diversity-based personal information, if you choose to provide it, namely:
 - Ethnic Group(s)
 - Religion and/or Spiritual Self-Identity
 - Sexual Orientation
 - Disability

You may select the "Prefer not to answer" response option available for each question if you choose not to provide your diversity-based personal information. No program, service or benefit will be withheld should you choose not to provide your diversity-based personal information.

- We collect information about the OUAC voucher, if you choose to pay for your application using an OUAC voucher purchased by a Chosen University.
- We collect your registration information from the Ontario Ministry of Colleges and Universities (MCU) if you are accepted
 and then register at an Ontario university.

Use of Personal Information

- We use your personal information to compile and process your application, as set out in our Privacy Statement.
- If you applied last year, and you are applying this year, for admission to undergraduate degree-granting and/or nondegree-granting programs at universities in Ontario, we may use the academic information that we collected last year to process your application this year.
- If you order academic transcripts in support of your application, we will use your personal information to process your transcript request.
- We and/or your Chosen Universities may use your personal information, including but not limited to, your date of birth or OEN, for identification and document matching.
- We may combine information collected from the MCU on university registration with your personal, academic, application choice, offer, and confirmation information, collected as part of your application to create data and aggregated data and reports as set out in our Privacy Statement.
- If you choose to pay for your application using an OUAC voucher purchased by a Chosen University, we may combine the
 voucher information with your personal, academic, application choice, offer, confirmation and registration information
 collected as part of your application to create data and aggregated data and reports. The Chosen University that
 purchased the OUAC voucher that paid for your application may use the data and aggregated data and reports, in
 accordance with their own personal information policies and practices, for admission, enrollment and other academic
 policy development and research purposes.
- We may combine information about your status as an Indigenous person of Canada, your status as a first-generation
 applicant, your gender identity and/or your diversity-based personal information with your personal, academic,
 application choice, offer, confirmation and registration information collected as part of your application to create data
 and aggregated data and reports. Your Chosen Universities may use the data and aggregated data and reports, in
 accordance with their own personal information policies and practices, to:
 - Identify any unconscious bias or systemic racism in the admission process and to monitor any programs implemented to address any bias.
 - Inform you of specific programs, services or supports available to equity-seeking groups, in an effort to improve the
 availability of a university education for equity-seeking communities.
 - Support the admission process. Examples include, but are not limited to, making offers of admission and awarding scholarships.

Disclosure of Personal Information

- We disclose your personal information, including the personal information in your application, to each of your Chosen Universities. This information includes personal, academic, university/program choice data, offers and responses to offers, as set out in our Privacy Statement.
- We disclose your personal information to your Ontario high school and/or school board to assist in the application
 process. This includes a restricted number of Ontario high school and/or school board officials who are authorized to
 update your academic and diploma information that we store at the OUAC. The notices of collection of personal
 information for each Ontario government institution can be found on their websites.
- . We may disclose your academic information to the Ontario Ministry of Education in order to verify your academic record.
- If you order academic transcripts in support of your application, we disclose your personal information to the institutions
 where you ordered your transcripts from to process your transcript request.
- If you intend to apply for the Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) and provide your authorization and consent specifically for this purpose, we disclose your personal information to the MCU so they can determine your eligibility for financial aid.
- We and/or your Chosen Universities may disclose your personal information to the Ontario Ministry of Education to
 validate or assign an OEN. The notices of collection of Ontario government institutions can be found on the websites of
 those institutions.
- We and/or your Chosen Universities may notify universities and colleges across Canada and/or regulatory authorities
 and law enforcement, at our absolute discretion, if you withhold information or submit any information with your
 application that is determined to be false, misleading or written by a third party, or if it contains evidence of academic
 dishonesty or inappropriate or unethical conduct.

Applicant's Declaration

You consent to the personal information practices set out in the <u>OUAC Privacy Statement</u> and the Notice of Collection, Use and Disclosure of Your Personal Information Provided as Part of Your Ontario University Undergraduate Application.

You certify the following:

I certify that the personal information and documents submitted, or to be submitted, in this application, are true, complete and correct, including my declarations of citizenship and immigration status in Canada. I certify that any applicable autobiographic and personal submissions are true, accurate and authored solely and entirely by me and that all information requested in this application has been disclosed.

I understand that it is my responsibility to keep the OUAC and the universities where I have applied or registered informed of any changes to the information in my application, and I agree to update my application immediately after any such change occurs.

You also agree that you must:

- Provide the required personal information requested in this application, along with your application fee. Universities will
 not consider incomplete applications. Universities may require additional personal information and/or submissions to
 complete your application.
- Keep your OUAC username, password and application reference number confidential and secure. You must notify us immediately if you suspect any unauthorized access to, use or disclosure of this information.

Note: We and the universities reserve the right to verify **any** information provided as part of your application. If you withhold information or submit any information that is determined to be false, misleading or written by a third party, we and/or the universities may, at our absolute discretion, invalidate the application, resulting in its immediate rejection or in the revocation of an offer of admission or registration at a university.




Name

Enter your name as it is written on your passport, health card or other official document. Do not use all capital or all lower case letters. If you have only 1 name, enter it as both your first/given name and your last/family name.

If you are not able to change your name or date of birth, contact the OUAC [2] for assistance.

Name



- You must provide your first name/legal given name and last name/family name in full.
- Do not include nicknames, shortened names (e.g., Pat, Mike, Jenny) or initials.
- . If you have multiple first names, include them in the "First/Given Name" field.
- If you do not have a middle name, leave this field blank.

What first name do you use every day?

- Fill out this field only if the name you use every day is different from your first/ given name. Do not include your last/family name.
 - E.g., If your legal first/given name is James, but you prefer to be called Jim, enter Jim.
- This is the name the OUAC and some universities may use when they communicate with you and, in some cases, on official documents.
- Some institutions may require confirmation of your preferred name prior to registration.

Date of Birth

 We use your date of birth for identification and document matching, and for statistics.

Gender

- . We collect information about your gender identity, if you choose to provide it.
- You may select the "Prefer not to answer" response option if you choose not to provide your gender identity.
- . We use this information for statistics.

Have either of your parents or guardians attended a university or college?

- You may choose to indicate whether either of your parents or guardians attended a university or college.
- You are not required to provide this information; however, if you do, we will
 forward it to your chosen universities so they can inform you of specific
 services available to first-generation students.

Help | Former Last Name/Family Name

Applicants should Include this only if their legal last name/family name has changed, for example through adoption or marriage.

Help | What first name do you use every day?

The name you want to be called, if different from your legal given name. Do not include your last/family name. E.g., If your legal given name is James, but you prefer to be called Jim, enter Jim.

The OUAC and some institutions may use your preferred name for communications (e.g., mail, emails) and on official documents (e.g., offer letters). **Note:** Some institutions will use only your legal name for communications and/or official documents. Consult your university of choice for additional information.



Help | What is your current status in Canada?

Status in Canada and Country of Citizenship are mandatory fields. Permanent Residents must also enter their Date of Entry into Canada.

Note: A permanent resident is someone who has been issued a permanent resident visa by the Canadian government and has landed in Canada, but is not a Canadian citizen. Permanent residents are citizens of other countries. A person in Canada temporarily, such as a student, foreign worker or visitor, is **not** a permanent resident.



For all other status selections, provide the date you first entered Canada or the date you expect to enter Canada.


