Important Dates for Group A Applicants

JAN 15 2025

Deadline for applicants to complete their Ontario university application

The earlier they apply, the better. They can still modify their application after they submit it.

MAY 29 2025

Last day applicants can expect a response from an Ontario university

A response includes an offer of admission, a refusal or a deferral.

JUN 2 2025

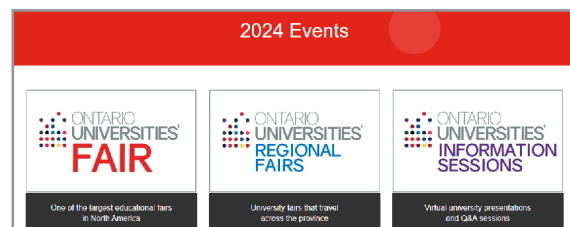
The earliest day applicants may be required to respond to an offer

They may also have to give a financial commitment (e.g., registration or residence deposit).

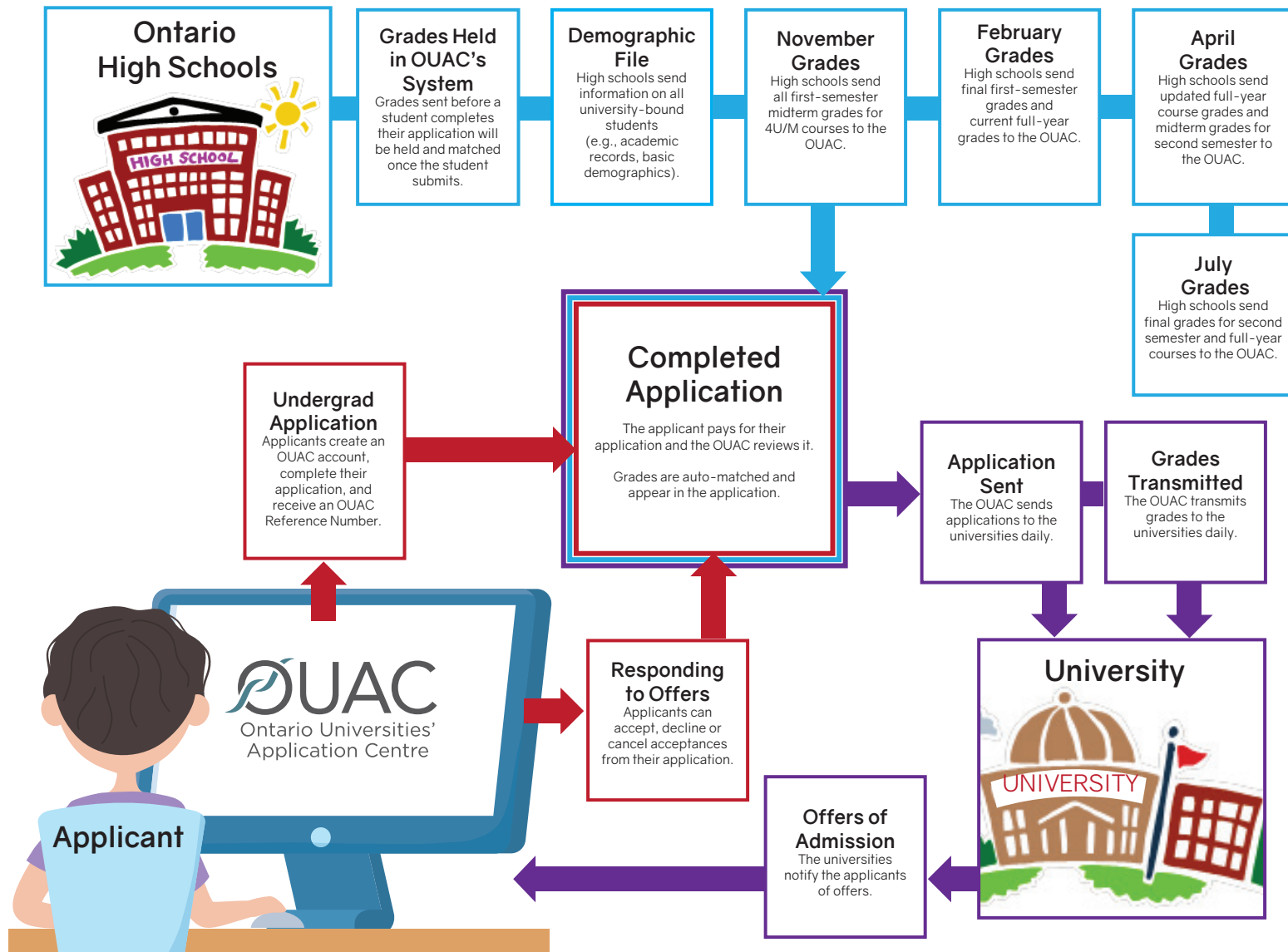
