Explanation of Choice Order

It does not matter how you number your university or program choices on your application. For the most part, whether you list a university or a specific program as first, second, third or higher, is not normally a factor in the universities' admissions decisions. Where there are exceptions to the policy of not using the choice numbering, the universities are to state their policies clearly in their own information literature.

Choice numbering does provide valuable information to the university admission offices. This is particularly true for limited-enrolment programs. 


