

The Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) was created by the universities of Ontario through the Council of Ontario Universities (COU). The OUAC has been processing applications on behalf of universities in Ontario since 1971. To apply for admission to a university undergraduate program and/or a non-degree-granting program in Ontario, your application must be processed through the OUAC. The OUAC forwards your application information to the university(ies) of your choice. By applying through the OUAC, you agree that the university(ies) of your choice will obtain the personal information you have provided to the OUAC and that the OUAC will collect, use, disclose and otherwise manage your personal information as set out in this Declaration and Notice.

The personal information requested in this application is required by the OUAC and by the university(ies) for the purpose of your application and must be provided together with your application fee. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Universities may require additional personal information from you to complete your application. Universities may use and disclose your personal information for other purposes in accordance with their own admission and personal information policies and practices, including requirements for government enrollment reporting, which you must investigate yourself. For example, some programs at some universities (e.g., Nursing) may require you to provide them with information about whether and to what extent you have a prior criminal record. It does not matter how you number your university or program choices on your application. For the most part, whether you list a university or a specific program as first, second, third or higher, is not normally a factor in the universities' admissions decisions.
