

Am I responsible for sending my high school midterm grades to the university?

Applications: Undergrad (101) Categories: Application Process

No, not usually. In most cases your Ontario secondary school grades are sent directly from your school to the OUAC and then to the universities you have selected. Sometimes, however, problems arise, in which case the university may contact you and ask you to provide secondary school marks. Be sure to provide them as quickly...

At the end of the application I see a warning and/or an error. What do I do?

Applications: Law (OLSAS), Medical (OMSAS), Rehab Sciences (ORPAS), Teacher (TEAS), Undergrad (101), Undergrad (105) Categories: Application Process, During Application

Please read any errors or warnings carefully. If you have a warning, you can proceed with submitting your application. If you have an error, you must correct it before you can submit. Return to the screen mentioned in the error message and correct the error.

Can I defer my acceptance until next year or later?

If you are admitted to a university but wish to delay your studies for a year or more, you will need to reach an agreement with the university in question. The university will determine any conditions. When you are ready to attend university, you may be required to re-apply through the OUAC. Contact the university...

Can I withdraw from a program and/or add a new program choice after I submit my application?

Applications: Teacher (TEAS), Undergrad (101), Undergrad (105) Categories: After Applying

Yes, you can do both by logging in to your online application and going to "Choices/Offers", as long as the deadline has not passed. To withdraw a program, select "Withdraw" in the Actions column beside the program. To add another program, select "Add Program".

Do I require the OSAP link to complete my application?

Applications: Undergrad (101), Undergrad (105) Categories: OSAP

No, linking to OSAP is an optional step meant to save you time in your OSAP application. You may link your OSAP and OUAC accounts any time after you have submitted your OUAC application.

Does it matter how I number my university or program choices?

Applications: Undergrad (101), Undergrad (105) Categories: Application Process

For the most part, no. Whether you list a university or a specific program as first, second, third or higher on the application is not normally a factor in the universities' admissions decisions. A university must make its policy clear in its own information where there are exceptions to the policy of using the numbered...

Due to a serious illness (or a death in the family or another cause) my academic performance was affected. What should I do?

Applications: Undergrad (101) Categories: Application Process

Universities may take special circumstances into consideration when making their admission decisions. Therefore, it is important that you keep your guidance counsellor informed of your situation. You may choose to ask your guidance counsellor to contact the admission office of each of the universities where you applied for admission directly on your behalf. The universities...

How can I check the status of my online application?

Once we receive your fee, process your application and distribute your application information to the universities, you can contact them directly for information about the status of your application.

How do I accept my offer of admission?

How many universities and programs can I choose to apply to on my application?

I accepted my offer online but when I go back in to my application, there is no acceptance listed in the "Applicant Response" column. What happened?

I am currently attending an Ontario high school, but I will have fewer than six 4U/M courses finished this year. Should I use the high school application (101)?

Applications: Undergrad (101) Categories: Which Application Should I Complete?

If the programs to which you wish to apply stipulate that you must present six 4U/M courses for admission and you will not satisfy this requirement, you should consult your guidance counsellor or the OUAC to determine the appropriate application.

I am currently attending high school, but have attended a postsecondary institution. Which application should I use?

Applications: Undergrad (101), Undergrad (105) Categories: Which Application Should I Complete?

If you are currently enrolled in a day program at a high school but have attended a postsecondary institution, you must apply through the 105 application. You must make arrangements with your high school to forward all of your academic data to the universities you selected.

I am in the process of completing my application and I noticed that none of my grades are displayed under "Current High School Information and Grades". Should I still complete and submit my application?

Applications: Undergrad (101) Categories: Application Process

Yes, you should submit your application. Your high school created an OUAC Account for you, allowing you to apply online, but has not yet added any academic data. You should contact your guidance counsellor to ensure that all of your previously completed and current courses are added to your application for you.

I am taking a summer school course. How will the universities get my marks?

Applications: Undergrad (101) Categories: Application Process

Grades from summer school courses are submitted to the OUAC by the summer school or the school board. Verify with your summer school that either they or the school board will be sending the marks directly to the OUAC on your behalf. If this is not the case, you must arrange for an official final...

I am taking courses at 2 different schools. How will my grades be sent to the universities?

Applications: Undergrad (101) Categories: Application Process

If you are taking courses at more than 1 school, the school that created your OUAC Account will be designated as your "home" school. Make sure your "home" school has an up-to-date record of all courses you have completed or are currently completing through any other school or study medium (such as private school, night...

I am trying to accept my offer online but it says the offer has expired. What can I do?

Applications: Undergrad (101), Undergrad (105) Categories: Offers of Admission

If the offer link is still active, you may select it to accept. The university is allowing you to accept this offer after the expiry date. However, before accepting this offer, you should contact the university to verify how long the offer is valid after the expiry date, especially if you are cancelling an accepted...

I changed my name in my OSAP application, why did it not change in my OUAC application?

Applications: Undergrad (101), Undergrad (105) Categories: OSAP

The OSAP and OUAC applications do not share personal and address (bio/demo) information on a continual basis. When you link, you allow the OUAC to share your bio/demo information with OSAP once. If you change your bio/demo information after linking, you will need to update both your OUAC and your OSAP accounts. To save time....

I dropped a choice but it still shows on my OSAP application. Why?

OSAP displays all of your OUAC program choices, regardless of their status on your OUAC application. In the event that you change your mind, you will already have an estimate.

I forgot my OUAC Account password.

I have accepted my offer online but have changed my mind. I now want to apply to a different program at the same university. How can I change my program choice?

Applications: Undergrad (101), Undergrad (105) Categories: After Applying, Offers of Admission

Contact the university's admission office directly for clarification, as some universities may issue you only one offer of admission. Depending on the university's policy for offers of admission, you could be advised to: Add the new program choice to your application. If you already have 3 program choices selected in your application, you will need...

I have decided to attend a university outside of Ontario next year. How do I cancel my acceptance to an Ontario university?

If you have already accepted an offer at an Ontario university and decide not to attend that institution, you must cancel your acceptance. Log in to your application. Go to "Choices/Offers". I have forgotten my login information. What can I do?

I no longer wish to link my OUAC and OSAP applications and wish to remove my consent. What should I do?

I want to add program choices to my application online but I do not want to pay by credit card. What can I do?

What Information Do We Collect?

We collect personal information about you in the following ways:

Information You Provide to Us

- We collect the personal information you provide in your application, or in reference to your application.
- We may ask for personal information that you are not required to provide to complete your application. E.g.,
 You may provide personal information in connection with special programs or surveys.
- We collect payment information when you pay (or someone else pays) for your application, except for payment card information.

Information We Collect from Third Parties

How Do We Use Your Information?

We use your personal information to:

- · process your application to Ontario universities and provide other services to you.
- · verify and confirm the information in your application.
- · maintain and improve the OUAC's application system.
- · contact you regarding your application and other services, including by email.
- · respond to your inquiries and requests.
- process electronic transcript and test score requests.
- · process and respond to any inquiries about your payment.
- create data and aggregated data and reports to be used by us, educational and governmental institutions and researchers.
- · conduct research and analysis and to assist others with research.
- · protect our systems and the integrity of our auditing process.
- investigate legal claims and enforce our rights and those of the Ontario universities.

We may use your personal information for other purposes we have obtained your consent for and for other purposes as may be permitted or required by applicable law.

Except as otherwise described in this paragraph, we keep current year and historic electronic versions of your application for 7 years, after which it will be destroyed in accordance with our Data Retention and Disposal Policy. At the end of each application cycle, we destroy any supplementary materials (e.g., personal statements, references, etc.) you submit in support of your application. Your information will not be returned, forwarded or copied to you before it is destroyed. If you create an OUAC account but do not submit an application, we will destroy your account and all related personal information (paper or electronic) at the end of the annual application cycle.

How Do We Share Your Information?

We keep your personal information confidential and disclose it only for the purposes described in this Privacy Statement. We share your personal information with the following third parties:

Universities

- We disclose your application information to the Chosen Universities you apply to. The Chosen Universities
 collect your personal information through the OUAC in accordance with their enabling legislation for the
 purposes of recruitment, admission and registration. The notices of collection of personal information for
 each Ontario university can be found on their websites.
- We disclose electronic copies of paper documents to your Chosen Universities, as specified in the
 application instructions.
- If you apply to a Canadian university outside of Ontario, we disclose your Ontario high school academic data to that university upon your request.
- · We provide your Chosen Universities access to correspondence about your application.
- If you apply to a joint or collaborative university/university or university/college program, we and/or the Chosen Universities you apply to, will disclose your application information to the relevant partner Ontario colleges or universities.

Service Providers

- We may transfer your personal information to third parties in order to process electronic transcript requests
 and to retrieve test scores. E.g., if you request an Ontario college transcript in support of a university
 application, we send your personal information to OCAS, which requests Ontario college transcripts on your
 behalf. We may also request transcripts and test scores on your behalf from other organizations in other
 jurisdictions in Canada and other countries.
- Where an admission test score is required for your application, we provide your personal information to the
 test score providers to obtain your test score. These test score providers may be situated in jurisdictions
 outside of Canada
- We may transfer your personal information, as required, to third parties who provide services on our behalf, such as hosting, data storage and processing service providers, research and analytics providers and auditors who analyze our systems to ensure that your personal information is protected.
- We share your personal information (or the personal information of the person who pays for your application) with your credit card company, if applicable, in order to obtain payment authorization. We do not retain any credit card information.

Note: Your personal information may be stored and processed in any country where we engage third-party service providers. As a result, your personal information may be transferred outside of Canada to jurisdictions that may have different data protection rules than Canada. While such information is outside of Canada, it is subject to the laws of the country in which it is located, and may be subject to disclosure to the governments, courts or law enforcement or regulatory agencies of said country, pursuant to the laws of such country.

Educational and Governmental Institutions and Researchers

- We may disclose your personal, academic, application, offer, confirmation and registration information to the
 Ontario universities and to Ontario high school boards for admission, enrollment and other academic policy

 institutions.
- We may disclose personal information to the Ministry of Education and/or the Ministry of Colleges and Universities for policy development and research purposes, as outlined in and authorized by the Education Act and the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities Act.
- We may disclose your demographic, academic, application, offer, confirmation and registration information to researchers (at the OUAC's discretion) for admission, enrollment and other academic policy development and research purposes.

Additionally, we may use and disclose your information when we believe such use or disclosure is permitted, necessary or appropriate:

- under applicable law;
- to comply with the legal process or other legal obligations, including our obligations under contracts;
- · to respond to requests from governmental authorities;
- · to protect our operations or those of the universities or other third parties;
- · to protect our rights, privacy, safety and property, and those of our affiliates, you and others; and
- to allow us to pursue available remedies or limit the damages that we may sustain, including the collection
 of debts you may owe us.

We may transfer your personal information and other information to a third party in the event of any reorganization, transfer or other disposition of all or any portion of our operations or assets.

How Do We Protect Your Personal Information?

We maintain administrative, technical and physical safeguards in an effort to protect your personal information against unauthorized access, use, modification and disclosure.

- We restrict access to personal information only to employees and authorized service providers who require
 the information for the purposes described in this Privacy Statement.
- We store electronic records off-site as part of our disaster recovery procedures. These records remain in Canada
- We use industry standard security during the transfer of data. All files transferred to or from the OUAC use a Secure Socket Shell (SSH) protocol. Files containing personal information have an additional layer of encryption.
- Our third-party service providers are required to maintain the confidentiality and security of your personal information and to use it only in compliance with applicable privacy laws.

Although we take appropriate measures to safeguard the personal information in our custody and control, we cannot guarantee that your personal information will always be used in ways that are consistent with this Privacy Statement and no method of transmission or storage of information is 100% secure or error-free, so we cannot guarantee absolute security. If you have reason to believe that your interaction with us is no longer secure (e.g., if you feel that the security of any information you provided to us has been compromised), please contact us immediately.

How Can You Access or Correct Your Personal Information?

During an application cycle, you can access your personal information online and, in most cases, make updates. In cases where you are not able to access your personal information online or make updates, you may submit a written request to review any such personal information about you that we hold and we will provide you with any such personal information to the extent required by law. We are committed to respecting your privacy. This notice supplements our <u>Privacy Statement</u> and applies when you prepare, complete and submit a 101 Application (for undergraduate applicants currently attending an Ontario high school). Please read our <u>Privacy Statement</u>.

By applying through the OUAC, you authorize us to collect your personal information directly from you and from other organizations, as necessary, to complete and process your application. You also agree that we will disclose to the universities to which you apply (the "Chosen Universities") the personal information you provide to us and other personal information we collect in connection with your application. The Chosen Universities collect your personal information through the OUAC in accordance with their enabling legislation for the purposes of recruitment, admission and registration. Universities may use and disclose your personal information for other purposes in accordance with their own admission and personal information policies and practices. Collection of Personal Information




